Immigrant Children and Youth Grant

As a recipient of the Immigrant Children and Youth Program Grant for 2015-16, this is to notify you that the RFP 136, Letter to Awardees and 2015-16 Final Entitlement list are available on the Connecticut State Department of Education Web site at 2015 Request for Proposals under the **Sheff Office**. For your convenience, the RFP 136 is both in the PDF and Word version.

This year's RFP will be judged more closely based on your **expressed NEED** for the funds and how they will benefit immigrant children. Please heed this closely.

The federal definition of immigrant students, foreign exchange students or students on a visa refers to individuals who:

- are ages 3 through 21 enrolled full-time in elementary and secondary school;
- were not born in any state; and
- have not been attending one or more schools in any one or more states for more than a total of three full academic years.

Your award is based on data collection, which might encompass students at private schools. The portion of the award based on those students must be spent on their behalf. Any expenditures, including personnel or purchases, must be done by the district. For example, any staff hired must be the district's employees. Any purchases made must be with the school district purchase order system. In addition, any educational entity receiving these federal funds must agree to abide by all civil rights laws and must have policies and practices in place, i.e., Title IX.

Any funds declined or any RFP not approved will have those amounts re-allocated to other districts entitled to the funds.
