

PROCEDURAL HISTORY:

Due process hearing was requested by the parent on August 26, 1999, and a prehearing conference took place on September 8, 1999. On the second day of hearing, December 10, 1999, the parties announced that they had reached an agreement in principle and requested time to reduce the terms of the agreement to writing. Upon execution of the agreement the request for due process hearing would be withdrawn. The hearing officer canvassed the parties who acknowledged their understanding of the terms upon which this matter was to be resolved. On February 9, 2000, counsel for the parents advised the hearing officer that an agreement had been signed and that upon receipt of a check the matter would be withdrawn. No further communication has been received by the hearing officer from either party.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

This matter is **dismissed** without prejudice.
