

SUMMARY:

The student is a 3 ½ year old boy who was diagnosed as developmentally delayed, requiring speech and language and occupational therapy, and eligible for special education under the Individuals with Disabilities Act, 20 U.S.C. Section 1401 *et seq.* The parents requested a due process hearing on October 7, 1999. At the telephonic prehearing conference, hearing dates were chosen and the matter came to hearing on January 4, 2000. At the hearing the parties came to an agreement and the agreement was put on the record. The parties were canvassed as to the agreement and they stated that it was correct as stated on the record. The parties agreed to have the due process hearing dismissed with prejudice.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

THE DUE PROCESS HEARING IS **DISMISSED** WITH PREJUDICE.
