

ISSUES:

1. Are the program and placement offered by the Board appropriate to N.'s special education needs upon discharge from Silver Hill Hospital?
2. Is the Board responsible for N.'s therapeutic costs as related services at Silver Hill Hospital?
3. Is residential placement necessary to address N.'s special needs?
4. Is the Board responsible for the cost of residential placement for N.?
5. Has the Board violated procedural requirements of IDEA and Section 10-76, C.G.S., by refusing to discuss alternative placements as requested by the Parent at a PPT meeting?

SUMMARY:

This hearing was requested on November 15, 1999, and a pre-hearing conference was held on November 24, 1999. It concerned services for a sixteen year old emotionally disturbed young man. When the hearing convened on January 14, 2000, the parties informed the Hearing Officer that a settlement had been reached and that the Parents had withdrawn their request for a hearing.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

This matter is **dismissed** with prejudice.
