FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Whether the program offered by the Board is appropriate.
2. If not, whether the student's placement at Foundation School is appropriate.

SUMMARY:

The matter was assigned on December 13, 2000. The prehearing conference was held on December 18, 2000. After the prehearing, a 30-day extension for the mailing of the final decision was granted so that the parties could pursue settlement discussions. The first hearing date was scheduled for January 24, 2001. At the first hearing day, counsel for both parties reported the case settled, and place their stipulation on the record.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED, with prejudice.**
