**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

**ISSUES**

- I. Whether the Local Educational Agency provided the child with a free and appropriate public education.

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY**

The parent requested a Due Process hearing on October 7, 2003. On October 8, 2003, the parties agreed to hearing dates of December 3, 10 and 11, 2003. Hearing convened on December 3 and 10, 2003. The parties believed they would be able to reach an agreement and requested a postponement of the December 11, 2003 hearing date. They anticipated the hearing would be dismissed with prejudice. To date the parties have not requested additional dates for hearing.
