FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- I. Whether the district violated the student's procedural rights?
- II. Whether the Board offered the child a free and appropriate public education for the 2003-2003 school year?
- III. Whether the district provided the student with a free and appropriate public education for the 2003-2004 school year?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parent requested a Due Process hearing on October 6, 2003. The case was assigned to the hearing officer on October 7, 2003. There was a prehearing conference on October 10, 2003. Hearings were scheduled to convene December 5, 8 and 15, 2003. The parties have been working to evaluate the student. The matter is dismissed without prejudice until they know more about the results of evaluations and the child's progress.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

The case is **dismissed** without prejudice.
