FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- I. Whether the district failed to evaluate the student?
- II. Whether the district failed to identify the student for Special Education?
- III. Whether the district failed to provide an appropriate program for the student?

The parent through counsel requested a Due Process hearing on December 11, 2003. The parties participated in a prehearing conference on December 17, 2003.
