FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Is the program offered by the Board for the 2003-2004 school years appropriate as required in 20 USC §§1401 et seq? If not;
2. Does the student require a residential program at the Elan School in Portland, Maine at the Board's expense?

SUMMARY AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY:

The student is a seven year old young child who has been eligible for special education and related services as defined in 20 USC §§1401 et seq. The parents requested a hearing on or about February 24, 2004. A pre-hearing telephonic conference was scheduled for March 1, 2004. At the pre-hearing conference the parents through their attorney withdrew their request for a due process hearing. There was no objection by the Board to the request of a withdrawal of the matter.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is DISMISSED, WITHOUT PREJUDICE.
