**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

The request for due process in this matter was filed by the Board for reason that the Parent was requesting an independent neuropsychological evaluation followed by the neuropsychologist developing and monitoring the Student's program. The Parent also wanted a one-to-one aide for the one and one-half hours that the Student did not have additional adult supervision. The Board rejected these requests maintaining that the Student was doing well in the program as currently designed and implemented. The date for mailing of the final decision was set at March 21, 2005. At the prehearing conference the Board advised that the Parent had obtained assistance from the Office of Protection and Advocacy and was agreeing to address the issues through the PPT process. The Board was therefore withdrawing their request for due process and the matter could be dismissed.

**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:**

The hearing is dismissed.
