FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Parents filed a due process hearing request with the State Department of Education (SDE) on March 21, 2006. This Hearing Officer was assigned to the case on March 22. The Board received the due process request on March 20, 2006. A prehearing conference was held on April 18 at which time the parties agreed to schedule hearing dates on May 15 and June 1, 2006. The decision deadline was extended from June 5 to June 25 to accommodate the June 1 hearing date. On May 3 the Parents' attorney wrote to the Hearing Officer and stated that a settlement was reached at a resolution meeting and that the Parents wished to withdraw the due process hearing without prejudice until an agreement could be drafted and executed, at which time they would withdraw with prejudice. As of June 13 no further correspondence was received from the parties. The Hearing Officer cancelled both hearing dates.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

It is ordered that this case be dismissed with prejudice.
