FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

The prehearing in this matter was conducted on April 13, 2006. Both parties participated and hearing dates that were agreed to were selected. The issues in dispute were failure to change the student's IEP, failure to increase the amount of instruction, failure to reconsider a manifestation determination from four months earlier and compensatory education. The date for mailing of the final decision was set by agreement at June 25, 2006. Prior to the first day of hearing the parties reported they were working toward a settlement and requested that the first day be cancelled. At the second date of hearing the parties reported they had reached an agreement but needed time to finalize it and requested the existing hearing dates remain scheduled. This was granted and prior to the third scheduled hearing date the Student's counsel reported that the matter had been resolved and requested that it be dismissed with prejudice.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The hearing is dismissed with prejudice.
