FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

This hearing was requested by the parent for a large number of issues including failure to evaluate, damaging the reputation of the student, inappropriate physical restraint of the student, failure to program in the least restrictive environment in the summer of 2005 and the 2005-2006 school year, and failure to plan an appropriate program for the summer 2006 through the 2006-2007 school year. A prehearing was conducted and both parties participated. Hearing dates were selected and then the parties requested that the first date be cancelled and that request was granted. At the second date of hearing the Board reported that the matter had been resolved.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The hearing is dismissed.
