**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

**ISSUES:**

1. Whether the Board provided the Student with a free appropriate public education [FAPE] during the 2004-2005 school year.
2. Whether the Board provided the Student with FAPE during the 2005-2006 school year, including summer programming.
3. Whether the Board offered the Student with FAPE for the 2006-2007 school year, including summer programming.
4. If the Board failed to offer the Student FAPE for the 2006-2007 school year, is Eagle Hill an appropriate placement for the Student.
5. Whether the family is entitled to compensatory education as a result of the Board's failure to provide FAPE to the Student during the 2004-2005 and 2005-2006 school years.<sup>1</sup>

**SUMMARY:**

The Board received this request for hearing on May 17, 2006. A prehearing conference was held on May 25. At the prehearing conference, hearing dates in July were scheduled. On July 19, the Parent's attorney notified the hearing officer that the parties had reached an agreement in this case.

**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:**

The matter is **DISMISSED**, with prejudice.
