FINAL DECISION

This matter began in June 30, 2006 and the prehearing conference was conducted on July 12, 2006. Both parties participated and the Student agreed to an extension of time for mailing of the final decision to accommodate the parties' desire to proceed to mediation and attempt to settle the matter.
