FINAL DECISION

The prehearing conference was conducted on August 18, 2006. Both original parties (the Student and Windsor Locks) participated and the Student agreed to an extension of time for mailing of the final decision to accommodate the parties' desire to proceed to mediation and attempt to settle the matter.
