FINAL DECISION

This hearing was requested by the Parent. The issues included compensatory education for the period of November 2003 to present, reimbursement for out-of-pocket expenses, including outside consultations for program development and tutor training, and undelivered service, the largest category of which was the student's extended school day services from November 2003 to present. Prior to hearing the Board reported that the matter had been resolved and the Parent subsequently requested that the matter be disposed of with prejudice in accord with the agreement that had been reached between the parties.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The hearing is dismissed with prejudice.
