FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Whether the Board's program for the Student for the 2006-2007 school year is appropriate.
2. If not, whether the Parents' requested placement at Lorraine Foster Day School with transportation is appropriate.

SUMMARY:

The Board received this request for hearing filed on behalf of the Parents on September 18, 2006. The hearing convened on October 26, at which time the parties agreed that the Student would undergo a psychiatric evaluation. The hearing continued on November 29 and December 18, at the request of the parties. On December 18, the parties reported that the case was settled.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED**, with prejudice.
