FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Whether the Board has appropriately implemented the Student's IEP, including appropriately contracting with the Learning House and providing Orton-Gilligham instruction.
2. Whether the Board has failed to conduct and complete an evaluation by Dr. Brucker.

SUMMARY:

The Board received this request for hearing on December 1, 2006. In accordance with the parties' requests for extensions of the mailing date of the decision, this hearing convened for 11 days from January to June, 2007. On the June 7, during the eleventh hearing date, the parties conferred and reported on the record that this matter had been settled.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED**, with prejudice.
