FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- I. Whether the Board appropriately implemented the Student's IEP during the 2005-2006 school year.
- II. Whether the Board provided a safe environment for the Student in the 2005-2006 and 2006-2007 school year.
- III. Whether the Board's program for the Student for the 2006-2007 school year was appropriate.

SUMMARY:

The Board received this request for hearing filed by the Parent on January 29, 2007, prehearing conferences convened on February 8 and February 15. On March 1, 2007, the Parent submitted notification that the parties resolved this matter.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED**, without prejudice.
