**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

ISSUES:

- I. Whether the Board's program for the Student for the 2006-2007 school year is appropriate.
- II. Whether the Student's placement at Logan River Academy is appropriate.
- III. Whether the Parents shall be reimbursed for the services of the educational consultant.

**SUMMARY:**

The Parents received this request for hearing filed on behalf of the Board on April 27, 2007, and a prehearing conference convened on May 4. On May 25, the Parents' attorney submitted notification that the parties had reached a tentative agreement, and that the scheduled hearing date could be cancelled.
