FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Whether the Board's program for the Student for summer 2007 and the 2007-2008 school year are appropriate.
2. If not, whether the Student shall be provided the Lindamood-Bell program for 20 hours per week as requested by the Parents.

SUMMARY:

The Board received this request for hearing on May 7. After the resolution session was held, the parties apparently resolved this matter. The hearing officer was not notified of this resolution in a timely manner before the hearing convened on June 26, although the parties were notified that the Parents should submit the notification in writing. On June 26, counsel for the Board confirmed that the matter had been settled.
