**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

**ISSUES:**

- I. Whether the Board offered the Student an appropriate program for summer 2007 and for the 2007-2008 school year.
- II. If not, whether the Parents' placement of the Student at Rumsey Hall for summer 2007 and the 2007-2008 school year is appropriate.

**SUMMARY:**

The Board received this request for hearing on August 22, and a prehearing conference was held on September 7. Prior to the initial hearing date, the Parents' attorney notified the hearing officer that the parties had reached a settlement agreement.
