FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Whether the Board's program for the Student for the 2007-08 school year is appropriate.
2. If not, whether the Student shall receive Auditory Verbal Therapy from a qualified provider for one hour per week.
3. Whether the Student's IEP goals shall be revised in accordance with the recommendations of the CREC consulting teacher.

SUMMARY:

The Board received this request for hearing on January 16, 2008 and a prehearing conference was held on January 28. On February 19, prior to the first hearing date, the Parents' attorney submitted notification that this matter had settled.
