FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES

1. Should the IEP agreed upon at the January 28, 2008 Planning and Placement Team ("PPT") meeting be implemented at High Roads Student Learning Center in Wallingford without the Parents' consent?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Board's attorney requested this hearing on February 25, 2007 by mailing a letter to the State Department of Education ("SDE"). This Hearing Officer was assigned to the case on February 26. On February 27, a prehearing conference was scheduled for March 6. On February 29, the Board's attorney sent the Hearing Officer a letter stating that the parties had entered into a written settlement on that date and that he wished to withdraw the hearing request with prejudice.
