**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

ISSUES:

1. Whether the Board's program for the Student for the 2006-07 school year was appropriate.
2. Whether the Board's program for the Student for the 2007-08 school year is appropriate.
3. Whether the Board's proposed program for the Student for the 2008-09 school year is appropriate.
4. Whether the Board has violated the Student and family's procedural safeguards.
5. Whether the Parents' placement of the Student at CCCD Academy for the 2007-08 school year [commencing February 15, 2008], summer 2008, school year 2008-09 and summer 2009 is appropriate.
6. Whether the Parents shall be reimbursed for the placement of the Student at CCCD Academy.
7. Whether the Parents shall be reimbursed for the home program, Dr. Smaller evaluation, related services and tutoring of the Student.

SUMMARY:

The Board received the Parents' request for hearing on March 3, and a prehearing conference convened on March 11. On April 22, the Parents' attorney submitted notification that the parties had reached a settlement of the case.

**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:**

The matter is **DISMISSED**.
