**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

**ISSUES:**

1. Whether the Board's programs for the Student for the 2005-06, 2006-07 and 2007-08 school years were appropriate.
2. Whether the Board's actions constituted procedural violations.
3. Whether the Student is entitled to compensatory education.

**SUMMARY:**

The Board received this request for hearing on April 2, 2008 and a prehearing conference was convened on April 11. On May 19, 2008, prior to the first hearing date, the Parents' attorney reported that the case was settled.

**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:**

The matter is **DISMISSED** with prejudice.
