FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- I. Whether the local educational agency provides the child with a free and appropriate public education?
- II. Whether the local educational agency has properly evaluated the child?
- III. Whether the parents are entitled to reimbursement for a summer reading program?
- IV. Whether the parents are entitled to reimbursement for private tutorial services and compensatory education?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY:

The Parents' counsel requested a due process hearing on March 21, 2008. At a pre-hearing conference on April 16, 2008, the parties agreed to set a date for hearing which would provide them with an opportunity to mediate the matter. The initial date for hearing was scheduled for May 29, 2008. The parties requested an additional date for hearing be scheduled for July 8, 2008 and agreed to extend the date for mailing the final decision in the matter to August 8, 2008. The parties have reached an agreement. They request the matter be dismissed with prejudice. The matter was resolved within forty-five days plus the extension of the date for mailing the final decision as requested by both parties.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

1. The case is dismissed with prejudice.
