FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- I. Whether the child's individualized education program provides a free and appropriate public education?
- II. Whether the child requires tutorial services to receive a free and appropriate public education?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY:

The Parents requested a due process hearing on June 27, 2008. The matter was assigned to the hearing officer on July 2, 2008. At a prehearing conference on July 23, 2008 the parties requested time to discuss settlement. The first day of hearing was scheduled for September 8, 2008. On the first day of hearing the parties reported they reached agreement. The parties requested the matter be dismissed with prejudice. The matter was resolved within 45 days as extended by the parties to pursue settlement negotiations.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

1. The case is dismissed with prejudice.
