**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

**ISSUES:**

1. Whether the Board's program for the Student for the 2006-07 and 2007-08 were appropriate.
2. Whether the Board's proposed program for the Student for the 2008-09 school year is appropriate.
3. Whether the Board failed to propose an appropriate ESY program in 2008 for the Student.
4. Whether the Board has committed procedural violations which have resulted in a denial of FAPE to the Student during the 2006-07 and 2007-08 school years.
5. Whether the Student is entitled to compensatory education.

**SUMMARY:**

The Board received this request for hearing on July 28, 2008, and a prehearing conference was convened on August 11, 2008. On September 8, 2008, the Parents' attorney submitted notification that the case had settled.

**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:**

The matter is **DISMISSED**, with prejudice.
