FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Whether the Board's evaluation of the Student was appropriate.
2. Whether the Parents shall be reimbursed for the April 2008 private evaluation of the Student.
3. Whether the Board's program for the Student for the 2006-07 school year was appropriate.
4. Whether the Board's proposed program for the Student for the 2007-08 school year is appropriate.
5. Whether the Board shall reimburse the Parents for the summer 2008 program and for the placement at the Academy of the Holy Family for the 2008-09 school year.

SUMMARY:

The Board received this request for hearing on August 12, and a prehearing conference was convened on September 2. On September 22, the Parents' attorney submitted a notification that the parties had reached an settlement in this matter.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED**, without prejudice.
