**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

**ISSUES:**

1. Whether the Board has failed to offer the Student FAPE for the 2007-08 and 2008-09 school years.
2. Whether the Student's primary disability shall be OHI-ADD, rather than Autism.
3. Whether the Parents are entitled to reimbursement of the Student's placement at Wooster School.
4. Whether the Parents are entitled to reimbursement for the cost of private therapy and a personal trainer.
5. Whether the Student is entitled to compensatory education.

**SUMMARY:**

The Board received this request for hearing on November 3, and prehearing conference was held on November 20. Extensions were granted at the request of the parties so that the parties had an opportunity to mediate the case. On January 15, the Parents' attorney submitted notification that the case had settled.

**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:**

The matter is **DISMISSED**, with prejudice.
