FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Whether the Board's proposed program for the summer 2008 and the 2008-09 school year were appropriate.
2. If not, whether the Parents shall be reimbursed for the summer 2008 placement at Eagle Hill Hardwick and the Student's residential placement at Franklin Academy commencing October 2008, and extending through the 2009-10 school year.

SUMMARY:

The Board received this request for hearing and filed a Challenge to the Sufficiency of the request, which was granted. The Parents filed an amended hearing request in response to the sufficiency challenge on March 24, 2009, and a prehearing conference was convened on April 1, 2009. Prior to the first hearing date, the Parents' attorney submitted notification that the case had settled.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED**, without prejudice.
