FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Whether Goal 6 of the Student's IEP of June 17, 2009 is appropriate.
2. Whether the consultant's name shall be listed in the IEP on page 8.
3. Whether the modifications and accommodations for the Student are appropriate.
4. Whether the IEP is appropriate in that it does not accurately list the Student's concerns/needs.
5. Whether the agreements as set forth in the IEP must remain valid for one year.
6. Whether the consultant shall be permitted to observe the Student on a quarterly basis.

SUMMARY:

The Board received this request for hearing on June 25, 2009 and a prehearing conference was convened on July 27, 2009. The mailing date was extended at the request of the Board's attorney so that the parties could continue good faith settlement discussions.

Prior to the scheduled hearing date, the Parent submitted notification that the parties were able to resolve all outstanding issues in this case.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED**.
