FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Whether the Board failed to convene a manifestation PPT to determine whether the alleged conduct which is the subject of the pending disciplinary action was caused by the Student's disability.
2. Whether the conduct which resulted in the pending disciplinary action was caused by or had a direct and substantial relationship to the Student's disability, or whether the conduct in question was the direct result of the Board's failure to implement the Student's IEP.

SUMMARY:

The Board received this request for expedited hearing on January 12, 2010 and the prehearing conference convened on January 21, 2010. On February 1, 2010, prior to the scheduled hearing date in this expedited case, the Parent's attorney submitted notification that the matter had been resolved.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED**.
