FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- 1. Whether the Board's proposed after school program at CCCD as set forth in the November 20, 2010 IEP is appropriate.
- 2. Whether the Parents' proposed extended school day home program is appropriate.
- 3. Whether the Student is entitled to compensatory education.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/DISCUSSION:
