FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- 1. Whether the Board failed to take action to identify the Student as eligible for special education:
- 2. Whether the Board had knowledge that the Student was a child with a disability prior to the conduct which resulted in the pending disciplinary action;
- 3. Whether there shall be a stay put of the expulsion until the Board conducts an expedited evaluation.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/DISCUSSION:

This expedited request for hearing was submitted on April 29, 2011. A prehearing conference convened on May 5, 2011 at which time the parties confirmed that the matter had been resolved. Therefore, this matter will be dismissed without prejudice.
