### FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

#### **ISSUES**:

- 1. Whether the Board's failure to provide the Student the required AT in a timely manner has resulted in a denial of FAPE;
- 2. Whether the Board shall provide the Student a computer installed with Kurzweill and Dragon Speak, as well as a head set and microphone compatible with Dragon Naturally Speaking;
- 3. Whether the Student is entitled to compensatory education.

## PROCEDURAL HISTORY/DISCUSSION:

The request for hearing was received by the Board on March 19, 2012 and a prehearing conference convened on March 29, 2012. At the prehearing conference, the Board reported a resolution session was scheduled to convene on April 2, 2012.

On April 13, 2012, prior to the first hearing date, the Parent's attorney submitted notification that the case was settled. Therefore, this matter is dismissed.
