FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES

- 1. Are the provisions of the Student's IEP for Occupational Therapy appropriate?
- 2. If not, should an additional hour of Occupational Therapy provided in an outside clinical setting be added?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Student submitted a Request for Impartial Special Education Hearing on June 4, 2012. The Hearing Officer was assigned to the case on the same day, June 4, 2012. A telephonic prehearing conference was held on June 12, 2012. Hearing dates of July 9, 2012 and July 12, 2012 were scheduled. At the subsequent request of the BOE, the hearing dates of July 9, 2012 and July 12, 2012 were cancelled, and hearing dates of July 17, 2012 and July 20, 2012 were scheduled instead.

On June 26, 2012, the Student requested that the hearings be cancelled and the matter be withdrawn without prejudice.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

It is ordered that this case is dismissed without prejudice.
