### FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

## **ISSUES:**

- 1. Did the Board provide the Student a FAPE in the LRE for the 2010-2011 school year?
- 2. If not, what relief is appropriate?
- 3. Did the Board provide the Student a FAPE in the LRE for the 2011-2012 school year?
- 4. If not, what relief is appropriate?
- 5. Has the Board proposed an appropriate IEP for the 2012-2013 school year?
- 6. If not, is the Parent's proposed placement appropriate and reimbursable?

#### **SUMMARY:**

A special education hearing in the above-captioned matter was requested by the Student's attorney and received by the Board on August 8, 2012. On August 20, 2012, Attorney Spencer appeared on behalf of the Parents and Attorney Yoder on behalf of the Board in a telephonic prehearing conference. On August 22, 2012, in accordance with the terms of a settlement agreement between the parties, the Parents withdrew the Request for Due Process.

## **FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:**

The matter is **DISMISSED** with prejudice.
