### FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

## **ISSUES:**

- 1. Did the Board fail to provide Student with a free appropriate public education in the least restrictive environment for the 2011-2012 and 2012-2013 school years by:
  - a. failing to provide a program with appropriate positive behavioral supports;
  - b. failing to conduct an appropriate functional behavioral assessment; and/or
  - c. failing to provide appropriate related services and extended school year services?
- 2. Did the Board commit violations of Parents' procedural rights, including but not limited to:
  - a. a failure to properly conduct a manifestation determination;
  - b. removal of Student from school through early dismissals and suspensions;
  - c. the predetermination of Student's placement at January 2013 and February 2013 PPT meetings;
  - d. failure to maintain a continuum of appropriate and alternative placements; and/or
  - e. failure of PPT to consider individual educational evaluation provided by Parents?

#### SUMMARY:

On March 4, 2013, the West Hartford Board of Education received a Request for a Special Education Due Process Hearing. The undersigned hearing officer was appointed on March 5, 2013. A prehearing conference was scheduled for March 28, 2013. On March 20, 2013, prior to date for the scheduled prehearing conference, Attorney for the Parents withdrew the hearing request.

#### **FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:**

In light of the above facts, the case is dismissed.
