FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- 1. Whether the Board failed to identify the Student as eligible for special education and provide the Student with FAPE;
- 2. Whether the Student shall be placed at the Forman School for the 2013-14 school year at Board expense.

This request for hearing was received by the Board on April 25, 2013 and a prehearing conference convened on May 2, 2013.
