FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Whether the Student was denied FAPE since April 29, 2015?
2. Whether the Student is entitled to compensatory education; and if so, for how long?
3. Does the Hearing Officer have jurisdiction over any claim by the Parent against the Board for any period of time prior to September 1, 2016?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Parent filed the Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on June 20, 2017. The Hearing Officer was appointed on June 27, 2017, and conducted a Prehearing Conference on July 18, 2017. On August 9, 2017, the Parent filed an Amended Complaint. Hearing dates were scheduled and noticed. On April 16, 2018, counsel for the Parent withdrew the due process request, with prejudice.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

In light of the above, the matter is **DISMISSED**.
