FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Did the Board deny Student FAPE for the 2016-2017 school year?
2. Did the Board fail to provide Student FAPE by failing to provide a program in the least restrictive environment?
3. Did the Board engage in predetermination that no program would be available for Student in the public schools?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Parent filed the Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on January 24, 2017. The Hearing Officer was appointed on January 26, 2017 and conducted a Prehearing Conference on March 6, 2017. The hearing was scheduled for April 6, 2017. The hearing convened on April 6, 2017. The Parent's attorney reported to the Hearing Officer that the parties had executed an agreement and that the Parent was withdrawing the Due Process Complaint with prejudice.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED** with prejudice.
