FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Did the Board offer FAPE in the 2016-2017 school year?
2. If not, is Wasatch Academy appropriate?
3. If so, should the Board be required to financially support Student's placement at Wasatch for the 2016-2017 school year?
4. Does the Student require a residential placement?
5. If so, should the Board be required to financially support Student's residential placement at Wasatch?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Parent filed the Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on December 21, 2016. The Hearing Officer was appointed on December 22, 2017 and conducted a Prehearing Conference on January 24, 2017. The hearing was scheduled for March 30, 2017. On March 27, 2017, the Parent's attorney reported to the Hearing Officer that the parties had executed an agreement and that the Parents were withdrawing the Due Process Complaint with prejudice.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED** with prejudice.
