FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Did the Board offer an appropriate program for the 2016 -2017 school year?
2. If not, is Eagle Hill appropriate?
3. If so, are parents entitled to reimbursement for the tuition and education related expenses for placement at Eagle Hill?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Parent filed the Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on April 25, 2017. The Hearing Officer was appointed on April 26, 2017 and conducted a Prehearing Conference on May 11, 2017. The hearing was scheduled for June 26, 2017 and postponed to July 10, 2017 at the request of the parties so that they could engage in mediation. On June 28, 2017, the Parent's attorney reported to the Hearing Officer that the parties had entered into a mediation agreement and that the Parent was withdrawing the Due Process Complaint with prejudice.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED** with prejudice.
