FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUE:

Did the District violate Student's rights under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act when it provided Student, who was homebound as a result of a medical condition, with only 4-6 hours per week of homebound tutoring?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY AND SUMMARY:

On June 5, 2017, the Rocky Hill Board of Education received a request for a special education due process hearing filed by Parent. The Connecticut State Department of Education appointed the undersigned hearing officer on June 5, 2017. On June 8, 2017, Parent sent an email to the hearing officer indicating that the dispute with the Board had been settled and that Parent was withdrawing his request for a special education due process hearing.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

In light of the above facts, the case is dismissed.
