FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Did the Board of Education unilaterally change the Student's placement?
2. If so, what should be the Student's placement?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY:

The Student initiated this special education due process case on May 7, 2018. This Impartial Hearing Officer was assigned to the case on May 9, 2018.

On May 15, 2018 the Student reported that the parties had resolved their dispute at a resolution session and requested that the matter be withdrawn.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

It is ordered that the matter is dismissed.
