ISSUES:

1. Whether the student should be placed in a therapeutic day program?
2. Whether the student is entitled to an IEE at public expense?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Parent, *through counsel*, filed the Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on October 20, 2017. The Hearing Officer was appointed on October 23, 2017, and conducted a Prehearing Conference on November 3, 2017. The mailing date was set to January 3, 2018.
