ISSUE:

Are the Parents entitled to an Independent Educational Evaluation (IEE) at public expense?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Board filed the Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on March 6, 2018. The Hearing Officer was appointed on March 6, 2018. A Prehearing Conference was held on March 28, 2018. A hearing date was noticed for May 15, 2018. Settlement negotiations were commenced and the Board withdrew the Due Process Complaint *via email*, to the hearing officer, on May 7, 2018.
